NEW: ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ONLINE NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 1, 2023
ALL TATOO CHANGES MUST BE MADE WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY BY
DECEMBER 31, 2023.

1. This is a closed entry show. **Entries MUST be made online by December 1, 2023.** Late entries will not be accepted. No exceptions. Entry fee must be paid at time entries are made. Breeder forfeits entry fee for animals scratched after December 1, 2023.
2. This is a one-day carrying cage show. All carriers must have leak-proof bottoms. Exhibitors are responsible to have their animals to the judging table for the proper class **and should not be expected to be called to the table.**
3. The show will be held in the Large Arena and all stock must be in the area by 8:00 a.m. Judging will start at 9:00 a.m. The arena will open at 7:00 a.m.
4. All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor prior to the show. Otherwise, the exhibitor forfeits all entry fees, premiums, and rights to exhibit.
5. No entry fee will be refunded except when an applicant withdraws her/his entry before the closing date for entries. Entry fees: \$3.50 per animal (Open or Youth); \$5.00 per meat pen; \$1.00 additional for Fur & Wool Classes.
6. **Health Requirements: Exhibitors will be required to read the Attestation Statement (last page in this premium list) and have a filled out and signed copy upon arrival with their animals.** Judges will eliminate any stock found to be diseased while judging. Animals in showmanship and hopping contests, as well as those on exhibit in the petting area, will also be screened for health issues throughout the week of Farm Show.
7. All animals that are to be exhibited are to be permanently and legibly earmarked in the left ear. All identification of stock will be by private ear numbers.
8. **All entries must list ear tattoo identification on the entry form. Failure to include all information on the entry blank will automatically disqualify your entry. All tattoo changes must be made with the show secretary by December 31, 2023.**
9. **Substitutions can be made only within the class. No exceptions. Substitutions must be made through Sarah Gregory (267-357-8037); gregorysk94@hotmail.com by December 31, 2023. No substitutions will be honored after this date.**
10. This is an Official ARBA Sanctioned Show, Eric Stewart, American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc., PO Box 400, Knox, PA 16232-400, Phone: 814-297-8233, Email: info@arba.net; and will be governed by the latest revised rules of that body. The completion of an entry blank indicates acceptance of these rules and regulations. Sanction Fees: Open \$25.00; Youth \$20.00. Dues: (*one year*) Adult \$20.00; Two adult combination \$30.00; Youth \$12.00; Family, Single Adult, \$20.00 plus \$5.00 per youth; Family, \$30.00 plus \$5.00 per child; (*three years*) Adult \$50.00; Two adult combination \$75.00; Youth \$30.00; Family, Single Adult, \$50.00 plus \$10.00 per youth; Family, \$75.00 plus \$10.00 per child. Exhibitors need not be members of ARBA to enter a sanctioned show.

11. All Best of Breed, Best Opposite Breed, the top ten (10) Youth Meat Pens, and the first-place animal in each meat class will be cooped and on exhibit for the remainder of the Farm Show. Only a business-card-sized advertisement may be placed on the cage card. No supplemental wires, cages, etc. will be permitted to be placed on the provided cages. **The completion of entries indicates acceptance of this regulation. Placement awards and premiums for the exhibitor's entire entry in Department 31 will be forfeited if the required cooped animal is removed and the exhibitor will be barred for two years.** These animals will be released on Saturday, January 13, 2024, from 5:00-7:00 p.m. All animals MUST be removed by 7:00 p.m. Cavies are not required to be cooped for the week because of drafts and temperature changes.
12. All animals must be exhibited in their natural condition. Exhibitors found violating this rule will have their animal disqualified and the remainder of their entry will be disqualified from competition and not be judged. Included in violations is dying, plucking, trimming, or any other action designed to deceive.
13. Only breeds and varieties currently recognized in the ARBA Standards of Perfection will be permitted to show.
14. Exhibitors must bring a food dish and water bottle to hang on outside of cage.
15. Exhibitors attempting to interfere with or influence a judge or acting in an unbecoming manner will be rejected and barred from the show with entry fees and premiums forfeited.
16. A Rabbit department delegate will clean the rabbits' cages every day. Self-cleaning is not an option. The completion of an entry blank indicates acceptance of this regulation.
17. There will be no selling of any rabbits/cavies throughout the duration of the Farm Show.
18. Youth/Junior classes are open to 4-H Club and FFA members. Exhibitors must have been born from 2004 through 2014 inclusive. Exhibitors must be 4-H member carrying a rabbit project under the supervision of the Pennsylvania State University Agricultural Extension Service or a dues-paying FFA member carrying a rabbit project under the supervision of Pennsylvania State University Agricultural and Cooperative Extension Service or a Vocational Agriculture Instructor and must be a member in good standing as defined by the state 4-H or FFA Office.

SPECIAL RABBIT MEAT PEN REGULATIONS:

GENERAL

Identification: Rabbits will be **permanently** tattooed with the youth exhibitor's private ear number.

Arrival time: All youth rabbit meat pens must be in place by 8 a.m. on Friday, January 5, 2024. Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Drug free affidavits apply. Judges will eliminate any stock found to be diseased.

JUNIOR RABBIT MEAT PEN CLASS

1. Each exhibitor is limited to one rabbit meat pen. In preparation for Farm Show, up to 10 rabbits may be tattooed.
2. A meat pen consists of three rabbits of the same breed and variety (*color*) as recognized and accepted in the current edition of the ARBA Standards of Perfection. They may be up to 10 weeks old (*70 days maximum*) and must weigh a minimum of 3 1/2 lbs. and maximum of 5 1/2 lbs. individually.
3. Youth exhibitors must own the doe(s) and kits must be kindled in the owner's rabbitry October 27, 2023, or later.
 - a. Owner must notify their county agent, 4-H club leader, or FFA advisor of their intent to enter a meat pen before the doe is bred.
 - b. Exhibitor must notify their county agent, 4-H club leader, or FFA advisor within three days of the doe's kindling.
 - c. Exhibitor must tattoo all rabbits to be grown for competition at 4 weeks of age in the presence of the extension educator, official 4-H leader or FFA advisor. Up to 10 rabbits may be tattooed. The educator or advisor must then sign the compliance statement listing the tattoo numbers.
 - d. Compliance statement must be submitted by December 15, 2023, via email to farmshow.rabbits@gmail.com.
4. Pen entry form must be submitted online by December 1, 2023, with the correct entry fee.
5. The exhibitor will choose three rabbits to present for competition who are most uniform in weight, show the best meat characteristics, and have no disqualifications as listed in the ARBA Standards of Perfection.
6. Exhibitors will present their meat pen at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, January 5, 2024, to be weighed, checked for health requirements and disqualifications, and judged. Judging will be done by an ARBA licensed judge.

7. The top 10 meat pens will be auctioned as part of the Junior Market Auction beginning at 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday, January 9, 2024, in the Small Arena. All rabbits selling in the Junior Market Animal Sale must be sold for slaughter through the buy-back program.
8. Any youth exhibiting a junior rabbit meat pen must show her/his own pen of animals. In a case where the exhibitor is physically unable to attend the show due to ill health or family tragedy, another youth exhibitor must show the meat pen of rabbits.

DIVISION 0001

MEAT CLASSES

1. Youth Stewer: One rabbit, 6 months of age and over, minimum weight 8 pounds.
2. Youth Roaster: One rabbit, under 6 months, not less than 5.5 pounds nor over 9 pounds in weight.
3. Youth Single Fryer: One rabbit, not over 10 weeks, 3.5 to 5.5 pounds weight.
4. Youth Meat Pen: Three rabbits, all same breed and variety, not over 10 weeks, 3.5 to 5.5 pounds weight each rabbit.
5. Stewer: One rabbit, 6 months of age and over, minimum weight 8 pounds.
6. Roaster: One rabbit, under 6 months, not less than 5.5 pounds nor over 9 pounds in weight.
7. Single Fryer: One rabbit, not over 10 weeks, 3.5 to 5.5 pounds weight.
8. Meat Pen: Three rabbits, all same breed and variety, not over 10 weeks, 3.5 to 5.5 pounds weight each rabbit.

ANGORA PALOOZA

Thursday, January 11, 2024 at 8:00 a.m. in the Small Arena

For the 108th PA State Farm Show celebration, the Rabbit Department will be holding a rabbit to finished woven scarf competition! This competition is a compact, angora version of the annual Sheep to Shawl Contest and will be used to demonstrate one of the dual purposes of the rabbit industry. All scarves will be auctioned off at the PA Farm Show. Rules for the competition are as follows:

1. Entries must be postmarked no earlier than October 14, 2023.
2. Additional entry forms can be obtained through Angie Myers, (717) 395-4581, Email: shawfamily@bluemountainfarms.net.
3. Entry fee of \$30.00 is non-refundable.
4. The teams may consist only of youth up to and including age 18 by December 31, 2023, or a combination of youth and adults, or all adults.
5. The Pennsylvania Angora Palooza Contest is open to Pennsylvania teams. Each team shall consist of up to five members: three (3) spinners, one (1) weaver, one (1) alternate or carder. A maximum of five (5) teams will participate.
6. Each team will supply up to two rabbits for the weft yarn during the contest. The fiber must come from one harvest from up to two rabbits and must be done at the contest.
7. A panel of two (2) experienced judges will judge the contest on the following basis: team identification 10 points; fiber presentation and suitability 10 points; spinning 30 points; weaving 20 points; design 30 points; for a total of 100 points. Bonus points for time will be awarded as follows: first team finished-10 points; second-8 points; third-6 points; fourth-4 points; fifth-2 points. JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
8. No drum carders or electric bobbin winders will be allowed. Hand carding is not required.
9. Scarf requirements are as follows: The finished scarf will be a minimum of 10 inches wide and a minimum of 70 inches long. In addition, all scarves must have a minimum of 5 inches of fringe on each end. In order for the scarf to be judged and be eligible for the shawl auction, the woven area must measure a minimum of 70 inches off the loom and be completely finished by knotting or hemstitching the ends by the end of the time allotted. In addition, no scarf will be eligible for auction if the woven area is less than five picks per inch.
10. Each team will supply their own warp and thread the loom before the contest. The minimum space is eight EPI, however, minimum of six EPI will be allowed to compensate special designs. Warp must be 100% natural fibers, 50% of which MUST BE ANGORA (no exceptions).
11. Weft yarn must be Angora rabbit fiber (no exceptions) and will not exceed three times the diameter of the warp.
12. Each team will supply all equipment, including spinning wheels, cards, looms, etc. Chairs are provided upon request.
13. Each team will identify themselves with distinctive signs/banners and distinctive dress.
14. Scarves will be auctioned at the fair. Proceeds from the auction will be given back to the individual teams.
15. Teams must have scarves completed and off the loom in three hours to be eligible for ribbons, awards, and auction.
16. Each team is encouraged to have on display a completed wrap or sample of the weaving pattern but not required.

Farm Show Exhibitor Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease Attestation: Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease

Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease (RHD) is a fatal disease of domestic and wild rabbits of the family Leporidae, which includes hares, jackrabbits and cottontails. RHD is caused by a calicivirus and there are several strains of RHD virus which cause disease.

Isolated cases of RHD have appeared intermittently in the United States since 2000. In 2020, outbreaks of RHD have been reported in domestic rabbits, cottontail rabbits, and hares in the United States. Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease Virus Serotype 2 (RHDV-2) has been reported in numerous states including AZ, CA, CO, FL, ID, IL, KS, MT, NM, NV, OR, SD, TX, UT, WA, WY

In Pennsylvania we have a quarantine order in place to prevent the introduction of RHD into our Commonwealth from rabbits that originate from one of the states listed above or other states in which the disease may have also been diagnosed in the last 12 months. The language in the quarantine states the following:

No rabbits or their products, such as, meat, pelts, hides, carcasses or other items, and no equipment, exposed feed or conveyances or other items or associated materials may enter the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from a Commonwealth, State, Territory, or Country where RHD has been diagnosed in the prior twelve (12) months or there is a reasonable suspicion it exists **unless** they meet the following requirements:

(a) All live rabbits must be accompanied by an Interstate Certificate of Veterinary inspection (ICVI) and must be examined by an accredited veterinarian within the seventy-two (72) hours prior to the date of shipment to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The ICVI must include statements by an accredited veterinarian certifying that:

(i) All rabbits in the shipment have been examined for and found free of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases;

(ii) All rabbits have originated from a single premises that has no signs of infectious, contagious or communicable disease in rabbits;

(iii) There have been no movements of rabbits onto the premises of origin within the 90 days prior to the date of shipment; and

(iv) The rabbits have had no contact with wild or captive rabbits other than their cohorts in the 90 days prior to the date of shipment.

(b) No rabbits or their products, such as, meat, pelts, hides, carcasses or other items, and no equipment, exposed feed or conveyances or other items or associated materials may enter the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from a premises exposed to, contaminated with or known to be affected with RHD, or where there is a reasonable suspicion the disease exists or the rabbits have been exposed to or infected with RHD.

In Pennsylvania Vaccination of rabbits for RHDV2 is conditionally allowed by licensed Veterinarians. Exhibitors are encouraged to vaccinate rabbits especially show rabbits that are high risk and follow best management procedures (BMPs) before during and after shows in regard to sanitation, cleaning and disinfection and post exhibition isolation. Exhibitors should not share or swap any equipment, cages or feed. Vaccination against RHDV2 does not exempt rabbits from meeting all import requirements in the above indented section. USDA Guidance regarding RHDV and BMPs can be found at:
