RULES

- 1. Entries: ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE AND PAID ONLINE.** Each exhibitor may enter and exhibit no more than two entries in any one class. The open show entry fee is \$20 per animal and must accompany the online entry application. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to see that entries are made correctly and on time.**
- 2. Ownership:** Females may show with joint ownership provided one of the owners is the exhibitor. Bulls may show with joint ownership provided one of the owners is the exhibitor and that the bull was maintained on the exhibitor's farm at least four months of the preceding year. To be eligible for showing, the **original** registration certificate must be presented and must show the **transfer** of ownership of purchased animals, or the registry of cattle bred by the exhibitor, no later than the date entries close for the Farm Show.
- 3. Tattoo identification:** To be eligible to show, all animals must have a **legible** tattoo that agrees with the registration certificate.
- 4. All Other Breeds (AOB):** The AOB division is established for recognized breeds with an open herd book for which shows are not otherwise offered, including Shorthorn Plus, Chianina, ChiAngus, etc. Chianina and ChiAngus breeding cattle must have a minimum of 6.25% Chianina blood and ACA registration papers. Both the cow and calf in cow/calf classes must qualify for exhibition in the AOB division. For questions about eligibility, contact the PA Farm Show (farmshow@pa.gov or (717) 787-5373) prior to entry.
- 5. All Other Purebreds (AOPB):** All Other Purebreds (AOPB) division is established for breeds for which there is not an individual breed show. AOPB is defined as registered animals whose sire and dam originate from the same registry. In the case of recognized breeds within an open herd book, individuals entered in the show must be designated as "purebred" or "high percentage" as designated by the breed association's colored registration certificate. Both the cow and calf in cow/calf classes must qualify for exhibition in the AOPB division. For questions about eligibility, contact the PA Farm Show (farmshow@pa.gov or (717) 787-5373) prior to entry.
- 6. Extra Stall Space:** Prior to the entry deadline, exhibitors with one to four cattle may purchase up to two total extra spaces and exhibitors with more than four cattle may purchase up to four total extra spaces. Each additional space costs \$20.00.
- 7. Blocking Chutes:** A \$40 fee must be paid prior to November 2, 2023, for each beef cattle blocking chute to be used during the Pennsylvania Farm Show. Each firm, farm, or family is limited to one chute for one to three animals, two chutes for four to six animals, etc. A fee of \$50 must be paid for the first chute above these limits and \$100 each for all others. A sticker will be furnished by Show Management to serve as proof of payment. Blocking chutes must have this sticker affixed to the right rear upright at eye level. All chutes must be kept out of aisles and in designated areas or they will be removed from the grounds.
- 8. Barns Open:** The barns will be open on January 1, 2024 and January 2, 2024 from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. for beds to be prepared. Barns will close promptly at the listed times and exhibitors must immediately leave. Any beds prepared or signs placed prior to the listed date will be removed by Show Management.
- 9. Tie Outs:** Tie-outs cannot be reserved prior to 8 a.m. on January 1, 2024. All tie outs must be reserved with a sign listing the exhibitor or farm name and a phone number. 10' x 10' (max) pens may be constructed in the designated tie out area with a minimum stocking density of 2 animals per pen. Tie out space is limited. Please be courteous to other exhibitors.
- 10. Stalling:** The available room for beef cattle is limited. Stalls will be assigned on the basis of the number of entries by each exhibitor. Each exhibitor's area will be clearly marked and there will be a chart posted listing stalling assignments. All exhibitors will use stalls assigned to them. These facilities are to be used only to tie livestock. In the case of animals entered but not exhibited, management will reassign excess stalls as deemed necessary.
- 11. Check-In:** Open-only Simmental, MaineTainer, SimGenetics, AOB and AOPB division breeding cattle entries will be checked in on Thursday, January 4, 2024, from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. All other open and junior breeding cattle entries will be checked in from 10:00 a.m. to noon on Saturday, January 6, 2024. Exhibitors must furnish **original** breed registration papers at that time. **No photostats, facsimiles, or copies will be accepted.** Tattoos will also be checked at that time. All required tattoos must be **legible** and match registration papers.
- 12. Grooming:** Use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat-producing animals when fitting any animal for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat. If it is not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat animals, don't use it!
- 13. Unethical Fitting:** Any animal showing any evidence of unethical fitting practices such as tampering with the natural fleshing and muscle development (including but NOT limited to drenching and pumping of fluids) will be barred from the show and no premiums will be awarded. **No exhibitors shall be allowed to use any coloring agents on any animal exhibited. The Farm Show may adopt and implement various tests designed to monitor this prohibition, including but not limited to a "white glove" or "white towel" test. No aerosol cans or other pressurized containers will be allowed in designated makeup areas. Designated makeup areas will be the Lower Spine and arena areas. Any exhibitor found to be using coloring agents will forfeit all ribbons and premiums and will not be permitted to show for one year.**
- 14. Splitting large classes:** Farm Show Management shall have the option of splitting any beef cattle class **greater** than 10 head. This will be accomplished by dividing the class as evenly as possible without splitting animals with the same birth date. Full premiums will be awarded in each class.
- 15. Group Classes:** Family members' animals registered in Junior members' names and entered in the Open Show may be treated as family entries in the group classes, as long as juniors are 19 years old or less as of January 1 of current year. For the purpose of Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder points, an exhibitor will be considered a Jr. member and their family as one, as explained above.
- 16. Animals Entered and Not Shown:** A penalty of \$100.00 per animal will be assessed to the owner for each beef animal entered and not exhibited (shown) at the Farm Show. Entries cancelled on or before December 22, 2023, will cause forfeiture of entry fees without penalty. In **extreme or unusual circumstances**, a written appeal of the assessment of the penalty or vet excuse will be considered if received by the **Farm Show Manager** on or before January 16, 2024.
- 17. Release Time:** All beef cattle that show in the open show on Friday are able to leave by Saturday at 6:00 a.m. Junior cattle that are not showing on Monday are allowed to leave anytime between 8:00 p.m. Sunday January 7 and 6:00 a.m. on Monday, January 8, 2024. All other beef cattle (except for market beef) are dismissed at 6 p.m. on Monday, January 8, 2024. Cattle must vacate the North Hall and North West Hall by 8 p.m. on Monday, January 8, 2024. Cattle may remain in tie-outs until 6:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 10, 2024. **All cattle must vacate the**

North Barn by 6:00 p.m. on Monday, January 8, 2024. All cattle must vacate the Northwest Barn by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 9, 2024. Any exhibit removed prior to the listed times without Show Management approval will result in a forfeit of all premiums.

- 18. Supreme Champions:** An Open Show Supreme Champion Bull and a Supreme Champion Female will be selected from the Grand Champions of all breeds at the conclusion of the beef cattle show on Monday, January 8, 2024. \$250 will be award to the Supreme Champion Bull and Supreme Champion Female. A Junior Show Supreme Champion Female will be selected on Sunday, January 7, 2024 following 15 minutes after the conclusion of the Breeding Show.
- 19. Nose Ring/Lead:** All bulls 10 months of age or older must be shown with a nose lead or ring.
- 20. Premiums:** The Farm Show contribution to premiums will be the same for all breeds, except Angus, as follows:

**OPEN CLASS • PARTICIPATION STATEMENT
AMERICAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION**

The American Angus Association®, 3201 Frederick Ave., St. Joseph, Mo., will participate in premiums offered for open Angus breeding cattle classes according to the premium schedule based on the number of head shown. The premium assistance provided by the American Angus Association for participation in this show is in addition to the premiums offered by the show itself. The premium assistance should not be used to offset show expense and shall be included in the premium payments distributed by the show to the exhibitors.

A minimum of 50 head must be shown in the open class division to receive American Angus Association premium participation for the following year.

Premiums from the Association are paid only to registered Angus cattle and only if the registration number is a part of the show report provided to the Association. Therefore, all cattle should be registered at the time of entry to make certain they receive the Association’s portion of premiums. The Association does not pay on championship or any group classes (i.e. get-of-sire, junior get-of-sire, or breeder six-head).

Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate issued by the American Angus Association available for inspection at the show for each animal or another current proof of ownership issued by the American Angus Association pedigree look-up. Any animal upon check-in that does not have a legible permanent identification mark (ear tattoo marks, freeze-branded marks, or hot-branded marks) corresponding to the permanent identification mark on the registration certificate is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible permanent identification mark, animals cannot be re-identified (tattooed/branded) and rechecked at the show.

Any female shown with a calf at side: The calf must be the cow’s most recent natural calf, and the calf must be registered by show day and have proof of registration at check-in.

Only one person at a time shall lead an animal into the show ring.

Exhibitors who participate in shows that accept premium monies contributed by the American Angus Association are subject to the Association Rules as found in the Breeders Reference Guide of the Association. These rules are found in Part 2: Association Rules. The rules relating directly with the exhibition of Angus cattle are Part 2: Association Rules; Rule 800 Series; including Rule 800-810. These rules can be found at www.angus.org.

Altering the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair), with the exception of false tail switches. The use of graphite, powders, hemp, or other similar substances used externally are also prohibited. Other prohibited products include those used internally such as steroids, illegal or unlicensed pharmaceuticals, or artificial filling. Any animal found to be in violation will be barred from showing.

At any show for which the American Angus Association appropriates funds toward the payment of premiums, no exhibitors, individuals assisting exhibitors, or member owners at such show shall be allowed to use any coloring agents on any animal exhibited. The Association may adopt and implement various tests designed to monitor this prohibition, including but not limited to a “white towel” or “white glove” test. No aerosol cans or other pressurized containers will be allowed in designated lineup areas.

All animals exhibited are subject to DNA marker or blood type test to verify accuracy of parentage as covered under the Association Rules and for other testing as required by the individual show.

Authorized representatives of the Association have the authority to enforce the rules set forth herein as well as in the Association Rules, including the barring of a registered animal from a livestock show at which it is to be shown if there are reasonable grounds to believe a violation has occurred.

SHOW CLASSIFICATION FOR ANGUS

Only registered Angus cattle that meet the age requirements listed within this classification are eligible to receive premium participation and be counted in the total number of head shown - Champion and Reserve Champion placings are not counted in number of head shown.

Any female that qualifies for female classes in the Association's standard classifications is not eligible to show in the cow/calf classes. However, the calf at the side of the female is eligible to show in its respective class.

Cattle bred and owned by a junior member(s) may be included if the exhibitor of the breeders six head is an individual or married couple and is the parent or legal guardian of the junior member(s).
- 0758** Premier Exhibitor: Computed from winnings, 3 points for first prize; 2 points for second prize; and 1 point for third prize. 3 points for Grand Champions, 2 points for Reserve Grand Champions.
- 0759** Premier Breeder: 5 points for first prize, 4 points for second prize, 3 points for third prize, 2 points for fourth prize, 1 point for fifth prize. Points are given for individual classes ONLY of bulls and heifers. No points given for Champion or Groups. In case of ties, sixth place to be counted on a 1-point basis.

1. ALL CATTLE MUST BE PUREBRED WITH A RED REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW.
2. Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining thereto.
3. All animals must be registered as the property of the exhibitor in the records of the American Shorthorn Association as of the date entries close for the Farm Show.
4. Individual animals shown in all of the group classes listed below must have been entered and shown in their appropriate individual class(es).
5. Multiple-owned animals must be exhibited in the name of all owners.
6. Family bred and raised animals entered by Juniors in junior classes and subsequently entered in open classes may be treated as family entries in group classes. Exhibitor points may be awarded to an exhibitor for animals owned in partnership with non-exhibitors.
7. **Revisions of the Senior/Junior Yearling Pregnancy Rule for exhibitors at all open shows: Any senior/junior yearling female 28 months of age or older on the date of the show must have a natural calf at side and must be shown with such. All females 20 months of age or older on the date of the show must have a 60-day pregnancy verification signed by an accredited, non-owner veterinarian at the time the female is processed for the show. If a verification cannot be produced, the female may be allowed to participate if the exhibitor can produce a qualified veterinarian to examine the female at the show site and verify a 60-day pregnancy. Any infractions against this rule will lead to disqualification of that individual.**
8. All Shorthorns are subject to a tattoo inspection by representatives of the Association. All Shorthorns are also subject to an age inspection if deemed necessary by the American Shorthorn Association and the decision of the examining veterinarian is final. Use of artificial fins on show animals is not permitted.

Females

Special class for Cow-Calf pairs. Any female calved August 31, 2021 & older with their calf at side. Calf must be cow's natural calf, not embryo transplant. Applications for registration/entry of calf must be on file with ASA prior to show date. Owner of cow must be recorded owner or co-owner of calf. Calf is eligible to compete in individual calf classes but must be entered in the appropriate class. Cow/Calf does not compete for Overall Champion Female.

6. The use of false tailheads or adding hair or other material to any part of the animal's body is prohibited.
7. The dyeing or artificial changing of the existing color pattern and color will be prohibited.
8. All animals over 7 months of age must be de-horned.
9. Heifers exhibited at 20 months of age or older must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy. For heifers used in embryo transfer, a certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must be available for inspection.
10. Any and all cattle shall be made available to have blood drawn for parentage verification, detection of foreign substances, or the presence of altering. If recorded parent is excluded as a result of the blood typing, the owner may at her or his expense request the AMAA to determine the actual parent. Failure to determine parentage will result in disqualification of that animal from the AMAA herd book.

1. All entries in these classes will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations.
2. All applications for entries must be made online giving class number, age, and all other necessary information on or before November 2, 2023. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries per class.
3. All entries must have been owned by and in the possession of the exhibitor and solely registered in his or her name by November 2, 2023. Leased animals: See online rules at <https://www.farmshow.pa.gov/pafarmshow/exhibit/rules-regulations>.
4. **Eligibility:** <https://www.farmshow.pa.gov/pafarmshow/exhibit/rules-regulations>. Junior & Youth Division classes eligibility. These classes are open to 4-H Club members and Vocational Agriculture students. Exhibitors must have been born in the years 2004-2014. Exhibitors must be members of a regularly organized 4-H Club or be Vocational Agriculture students carrying a beef project in the previous calendar year under the supervision of the Pennsylvania State University Cooperative Extension Service or a Vocational Agriculture Instructor and must be a member in good standing as defined by the state 4-H or FFA Office.
5. No entry fee will be charged unless the animal is to be shown also in the open class in which case the fee of \$20.00 per head must accompany the entry form. All Jr. Show entries must also be registered for the Open Show.
6. **All Other Breeds Show:** Any breed(s) with fewer than three exhibitors will be combined with breeds not represented by an individual breed show to make an All Other Breeds Jr. division. In the Jr. show, All Other Breeds includes both recognized breeds with an open herd book (Shorthorn Plus, Chianina, ChiAngus, etc. for which Jr. Division shows are not otherwise offered) as well as registered animals whose sire and dam both arise from the same purebred registry for which there a separate Jr. division show is not otherwise offered. Animals showing as Chianina, ChiAngus, etc. Must have a minimum of 6.25% Chianina blood and ACA registration papers. Legible tattoos must match the registration certificate exactly. For questions about eligibility, please check with the PA Farm Show (farmshow@pa.gov or (717) 787-5373) prior to entry.
7. **Blocking Chutes:** A \$40 fee must be paid prior to November 2, 2023, for each beef cattle blocking chute to be used during the Pennsylvania Farm Show. Each firm, farm, or family is limited to one chute for one to three animals, two chutes for four to six animals, etc. A fee of \$50 must be paid for the first chute above these limits and \$100 each for all others. A sticker will be furnished by Show Management to serve as proof of payment. Blocking chutes must have this sticker affixed to the right rear upright at eye level. All chutes must be kept out of aisles and in designated areas or they will be removed from the grounds.
8. **Bedding:** Shredded wood fiber 4"-6" deep will be provided by the Farm Show. No other type of bedding is permitted in the beef cattle area.
9. **Arrival & Release:** Junior-only division cattle, must be in place by 11:00 p.m. on Friday, January 5, 2024. Junior cattle that are not showing on Monday are allowed to leave anytime between 8:00 p.m. Sunday January 7 and 6:00 a.m. and 6 a.m. Monday, January 8, 2024. Cattle entered in both the Jr and open shows must follow open show arrival and release times. Any exhibit removed prior to the listed times without Show Management approval will result in forfeiture of all premiums.
10. Angus exhibitors must have an original registration certificate issued by the American Angus Association on each animal available for inspection at the show. No other registration certificates qualify for exhibition in the Angus division. A heifer may be entered and shown with joint ownership provided the junior exhibitor is shown as the breeder and original sole owner of the animal.
11. **Junior Hereford Show:** An animal may be entered and shown with joint ownership provided the owners are siblings that both qualify for the junior division of the show.
12. **Substitutions:** Substitutions within breed for reasons satisfactory to management will be permitted on the opening day of the show, provided the animal to be substituted was owned by the exhibitor on or before November 2, 2023.
13. Exhibitors in these classes will be eligible to participate in the Junior Beef Showmanship Contest.
14. A penalty of \$100 per animal will be assessed to the owner for each beef animal entered and not exhibited (must be in the show ring) in the Farm Show. Entries cancelled on or before November 2, 2023, will permit a refund of entry fees with no penalty. Entry cancellations received after November 2 and before December 22, 2023, will cause forfeiture of entry fees without penalty. In extreme or unusual circumstances, a written appeal of the assessment of the penalty will be considered if received by the Farm Show Manager on or before January 16, 2024.
15. **Grooming Products:** Use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat-producing animals when fitting any animal for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat. If it is not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat animals, don't use it!
16. NO drenching or pumping of fluids will be permitted. Any violation will result in disqualification, forfeiting premiums and ribbons, and not being permitted to show for at least one year.

JUNIOR ANGUS HEIFER SHOW • PARTICIPATION STATEMENT

The American Angus Association®, 3201 Frederick Ave., St. Joseph, MO, will participate in premiums offered in individual classes for junior Angus heifers, as included in its standard show classifications, according to the premium schedule based on the number of head shown. The premium assistance provided by the American Angus Association for participation in this show is in addition to the premiums offered by the show itself. The premium assistance should not be used to offset show expense and shall be included in the premium payments distributed by the show to the exhibitors.

A minimum of 15 head must be shown in the junior Angus heifer classes to receive American Angus Association premium participation. The show is not required to have all classes to be eligible for premiums.

Separate classes for bred and owned heifers may be held if the size of the show merits a separate class.

To be eligible for Association premiums, the entries must be recorded in the sole name of the junior exhibitor and the issue date on the registration certificate must conform to the individual show's requirements regarding ownership. The Association's contribution is included in the total premiums listed in each class.

Premiums from the Association are paid only to registered Angus cattle and only if the registration number is a part of the show report provided to the Association. Therefore, all cattle should be registered at the time of entry to make certain they receive the Association's portion of premiums. The Association does not pay on premiums offered in championship classes. An animal may only be counted one time toward the total count for premium participation by the Association.

Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate issued by the American Angus Association available for inspection at the show for each animal or another current proof of ownership issued by the American Angus Association pedigree look-up. Any animal, upon check-in, that does not have a legible permanent identification mark (ear tattoo marks, freeze-branded marks, or hot-branded marks) corresponding to the permanent identification mark on the registration certificate is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible permanent identification mark, animals cannot be re-identified (tattooed/branded) and re-checked at the show.

Any female shown with a calf at side: The calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf, and the calf must be registered by show day and have proof of registration at check-in.

Only one person at a time shall lead an animal into the show ring.

Exhibitors who participate in shows that accept premium monies contributed by the American Angus Association are subject to the Association Rules as found in the Breeders Reference Guide of the Association. These rules are found in Part 2; Association Rules. The rules relating directly with the exhibition of Angus cattle are Part 2: Association Rules; Rule 800 Series; including Rule 800-810. These rules can be found at www.angus.org.

Altering the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair), with the exception of false tail switches. The use of graphite, powders, hemp, or other similar substances used externally are also prohibited. Other prohibited products include those used internally such as steroids, illegal or unlicensed pharmaceuticals, or artificial filling. Any animal found to be in violation will be barred from showing.

At any show for which the American Angus Association appropriates funds toward the payment of premiums, no exhibitors, individuals assisting exhibitors, or member owners at such show shall be allowed to use any coloring agents on any animal exhibited. The Association may adopt and implement various tests designed to monitor this prohibition, including but not limited to a "white towel" or "white glove" test. No aerosol cans or other pressurized containers will be allowed in designated lineup areas.

All animals exhibited are subject to DNA marker or blood type test to verify accuracy of parentage as covered under the Association Rules and for other testing as required by the individual show.

Authorized representatives of the Association have the authority to enforce the rules set forth herein as well as in the Association Rules, including the barring of a registered animal from a livestock show at which it is to be shown, if there are reasonable grounds to believe a violation has occurred.
