## Dear Exhibitor:

Your Alpaca entries have been accepted in the 2019 Farm Show for exhibit, subject to the rules as stated in the Premium List at <a href="https://www.farmshow.pa.gov/exhibit/rules-regulations/Documents/Department%2010%20-%20Alpacas.pdf">https://www.farmshow.pa.gov/exhibit/rules-regulations/Documents/Department%2010%20-%20Alpacas.pdf</a>

Animals may arrive at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex & Expo Center beginning at noon on Monday, January 7, 2019, and will be housed in horse stalls. Straw will be provided. No turf will be provided and is not allowed. Exhibitors <u>may</u> bring their own bedding.

A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be completed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of the opening date of the show and accompany your entries to the show. Remember to give it to your trucker.

There are specific parking lots for exhibitors' vehicles. The main parking lot is for cars and pickup parking only. All trailers must be parked at the grass area beside the Elmerton Lot. Enclosed is an exhibitor gate pass permitting free admittance into the exhibitors' lot.

All alpacas will be housed in the Northeast Barn. Plan to unload your animals at the Northeast Barn. Immediately upon unloading, please move your vehicle to the parking area to permit other exhibitors the opportunity to unload. ALL FIRE EXITS, FIRE LANE, HANDICAP, AND UNLOADING SIGNS MUST BE OBSERVED.

Your interest and participation is greatly appreciated. If for any reason you cannot exhibit one or more animals, please inform the Livestock Office at 717-787-2905 so the space can be made available to other exhibitors.
