Dear Exhibitor:

Your entry for the 2019 Draft Pleasure Show has been accepted for exhibit, subject to the stated rules and regulations: <http://www.farmshow.pa.gov/exhibit/rules-regulations/Documents/Department%201%20-%20Horses.pdf>.

Animals may arrive at the Farm Show Complex beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 9, and must be in place by 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 9. Horses will be stabled in the Equine Barn or the equine structure. Please check the website prior to arrival for stalling assignments. Entry paper check, health paper check, ring number distribution, etc., will be from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 9, and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. on Thursday, January 10, in the Show Office. **There will be a mandatory driver's meeting at 7:30 a.m. in the Show Office.** If an exhibitor/driver who has hitch entries does not attend the driver's meeting, all hitch entries will be scratched for that particular exhibitor.

Note: CARS AND WAGONS MAY NOT BE STORED IN THE COMPLEX AND WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE BUILDING ON SHOW DAY ONLY. ALL HORSE TRAILERS WILL BE PARKED AT THE OFF-SITE ELMERTON LOT. Also, in the interest of safety, you may not run horses through the passageways while entering or leaving the ring.

Any exhibitor who wishes to work from their trailer must notify the Livestock Office by December 26, 2018. If you do work from your trailer, you must arrive by 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 10, and must be checked in by 8:00 a.m. at the Horse Office. Parking for these exhibitors only will be in the Northwest Lot. Driver instructions will be given at check-in time.

Draft Pleasure Horses will be released at the conclusion of the Draft Pleasure Show.

Your interest and participation is appreciated. ***IF FOR ANY REASON YOU CANNOT EXHIBIT*** one or more horses, please inform the Livestock Office at 717-787-2905 immediately so that these stalls can be made available to another exhibitor. It is important that we have all stalls filled with horses at Farm Show time. Failure to show accepted entries will result in a \$100.00 per horse penalty as stated in Department 1, Rule 5, in the 2019 Farm Show Premium List at <http://www.farmshow.pa.gov/exhibit/rules-regulations/Documents/Department%201%20-%20Horses.pdf>.
