Dear Farm Show Rabbit Exhibitor:

Your Rabbit entries have been accepted for exhibit in the 2019 Pennsylvania Farm Show, subject to the rules as stated in the Premium List.

All animals may arrive at the Farm Show Complex beginning at 7:00 a.m. on Friday, January 4, and must be in place by 8:00 a.m. in the Large Arena. Judging begins at 9:00 a.m. in the Large Arena.

Please read the show rules in the 2019 Farm Show Premium List at <https://www.farmshow.pa.gov/exhibit/rules-regulations/Documents/Department%2031%20-%20Rabbits.pdf>. Any animal showing signs of eye or nasal discharge will not be permitted to enter the Farm Show Complex.

Space permitting, you may park in the exhibitor's parking lot (B) on Friday, January 4. Otherwise, you should plan to park in the large lot (F) north of the Exposition Hall. Parking is free on Friday, January 4. Rabbits staying all week will receive a parking pass for entry during the week. Rabbit Youth Showmanship contestants will receive a parking pass. Showmanship contestants must be in place by 9:00 a.m. and must check in by 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, January 5, in the East Hall. The opening day traffic is heavy. Allow for plenty of extra travel time.

Unload your animals at the West entrance of the lower concourse of the Large Arena, Overhead Door 50. Immediately upon unloading, move your vehicle to the parking area to permit other exhibitors the opportunity to unload. **ALL FIRE EXITS, FIRE LANES, HANDICAP, AND UNLOADING SIGNS MUST BE OBSERVED.** Offenders will be towed at the owner's expense.

Premium monies will be paid only to those classes stipulated in the Premium List. For youths to qualify for premium money, the youth exhibitor **must** be an active 4-H or FFA member in Pennsylvania.

All corrections/tattoo changes must be made with the Show Secretary by December 31, 2018. All incomplete entries (i.e., tattoo numbers, varieties, etc.) will be declared disqualified if not corrected by the indicated date. All changes/corrections must be made through the Show Secretary, Sue Toth, 179 Clinton Ave., Monongahela, PA 15063; 724-258-7582; msjtoth@comcast.net.

Changes **will not** be permitted after December 31 and will therefore not be permitted at the show.

All rabbit youth posters must arrive by 12 noon on Friday, January 4, 2019. The posters will be released after 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 12, 2019. Any posters not claimed will become the property of the Farm Show Rabbit Department.

Your interest is greatly appreciated and I look forward to having you exhibit the animals you have entered. Best wishes for a successful competition at the 2019 Pennsylvania Farm Show.
