- All entries in these classes will also be subject to the General Rules and Regulations. Health: Refer to the link above for Health Requirements. 1.
- 2.
- 3. Eligibility: Only registered animals may be shown in the Open Boer Goat Show. All Boer goats must be registered in the herd-book of a recognized association before the date of the show. Recognized associations include ABGA, and the Canadian Boer Goat Association.
- All animals must be registered purebred, fullblood, or percentage blood Boer goats. Percentage doe classes must be 4. 50% to 88%, Purebred/Fullblood doe classes must be 15/16 blood (94%) and higher. Bucks must be 31/32 blood (97%) and higher.
- An original certificate is required for all animals 6 months of age or older. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor on or before the date of the show. 5.
- An original certificate or stamped duplicate registration application is required on all animals under 6 months of 6.
- age. No faxed copies of certificates or registration applications will be accepted.
 Re-tattoos are acceptable when said tattoo matches the legible digits of the original tattoo, is in the same ear as the original tattoo, and an appropriate notification appears on the animal's registration certificate.
 Ages will be determined by the birth date on the registration certificate and calculated to December 31, 2023.
 Animals with natural horns, disbudded, or de-horned may be shown without regard to discrimination.
 An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased within 90 days of the show.

- 11. In classes where there is no competition, awards shall be made by the judge according to the merit of the animal. In
- class(es) where the quality of the animal(s) is **not** of Champion consideration type, the judge shall begin the class(es) with a second-place ribbon and the animal(s) shall not compete for Champion or Reserve Champion.
 12. To be shown, all Boer does must have kidded or exhibited pregnancy by 24 months of age.
 13. An exhibitor shall be limited to two entries in any one class. Entry fee is \$10.00 per head.

- 14. Arrival: Meat (Open Boer) Goats must arrive by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 10, 2024. Pens will be open to receive animals at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 10, 2024. All goats must be checked in with the Superintendent by 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 10, 2024. Release time is 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 13, 2024. Any exhibit removed prior to the listed times without Show Management approval will result in forfeiture of all premiums.
- 15. Substitutions are allowed in the same class only and must have same ownership as the original entry. Substitutions will be made at check-in.
- 16. Champion Classes: Competition will be limited to first- and second-place animals.
- 17. GROOMING: Use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat-producing animals when fitting any animal for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat. If it is not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat animals, DO NOT use it.
- **18.** Drenching is prohibited.

- 1. All entries in these classes will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations. All entries will be subject to the rules and regulations found on page 1.
- 2. Eligibility: These classes are open to 4-H Club and FFA members. Exhibitors must have been born from 2003 through 2013 inclusive. Exhibitors must be 4-H members carrying a meat goat project under the supervision of the Pennsylvania State University Agricultural Extension Service or a dues-paying FFA member carrying a meat goat project under the supervision of a Pennsylvania Vocational Agricultural Instructor. No exhibitor shall be eligible who does not take entire charge and care of his or her animals except in the case of illness or some other reason approved by the Farm Show Commission.
- 3. Health: https://www.farmshow.pa.gov/pafarmshow/exhibit/rules-regulations.
- 4. Entries must be computer timestamped by November 3, 2021. Entries must be made online at <u>www.farmshow.pa.gov</u> by the entry deadline giving all necessary information.
- 5. Entry fees: No entry fee.
- 6. **Ownership:** All animals must be owned by and be in the possession of the exhibitor by November 3, 2022, in the name of the junior exhibitor only.
- 7. An animal may show in one division only. Meat Breeding does cannot show in the Market Goat Division and vice versa.
- 8. Boer goats must be registered as fullbloods or purebred Boer goats to show in Boer classes. Percentage Boer goats must have papers listing the animal as a percentage Boer to show in percentage classes.
- 9. Arrival: Junior Meat Breeding Goats must arrive by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 11, 2023. Pens will be open to receive animals at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 11, 2023. All goats must be checked in with the Superintendent by 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 11, 2023.
- 10. Grooming: Use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat- and milk-producing animals when fitting any animal for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues. IF IT IS NOT CERTAIN THAT A PRODUCT IS RESIDUE SAFE AND APPROVED FOR USE ON MEAT AND MILK PRODUCING ANIMALS, DON'T USE IT.
- 11. Meat Breeding Goats released 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 14, 2023, and must depart by midnight. Any exhibit removed prior to the listed times without Show Management approval will result in forfeiture of <u>all</u> premiums.
- 12. Drenching is prohibited.
