#### RULES

An entry fee of \$1 per OPEN SHOW entry will be charged for each entry registered by 12/15/2023 An entry fee of \$2 per OPEN SHOW entry will be charged for each entry after 12/15/2023.

### -- ALL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ONLINE ONLY --Early entry is encouraged. Register online at www.farmshow.pa.gov ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6:00 P.M. JANUARY 3, 2024

- 1. Trees for competitive exhibit must have been grown in Pennsylvania on land owned or operated by the exhibitor.
- 2. Exhibitors may enter in as many classes or divisions of a class as they wish, but no exhibitor shall make more than one entry in a single class or division of a class, either in her/his own name, the name of a farm, or the name of some other person.
- 3. Preregistered entries may begin to arrive on Thursday, January 4, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. and must be delivered to the Maclay Lobby (Maclay Street side) of the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg by 11:00 a.m. on Friday, January 5, 2024, or they will not be eligible. Trees arriving earlier will be stored in the Maclay Street Lobby. New entries will not be accepted on site.
- 4. Trees to be exhibited shall be within the 6- to 8-foot range, measurements to be made from the bottom of the handle to the top of the tip. Tabletop-cut trees to be 48" maximum height.
- 5. No trees may be exhibited with limbs or foliage added that did not grow naturally in place.
- 6. No tree may be exhibited that has been sprayed with or has artificial color or other chemicals added in any manner.
- 7. Trees may be naturally grown or sheared and shaped by the exhibitor.
- 8. No holders should accompany trees. All trees will be supported in like manner.
- 9. Handles shall be well trimmed and 5 to 8 inches in length (Class 9 exempt). All handles less than 5 inches or more than 8 inches will receive a zero (0) score.
- 10. Judging will begin at 12:00 noon on Friday, January 5, 2024.
- All potted plants may be picked up by the exhibitor between 5 p.m.-7 p.m. on Saturday, January 13, 2024. Any exhibit NOT claimed by 7 p.m. will become the property of the Farm Show. Any exhibit removed prior to the listed times without Show Management approval will result in forfeiture of <u>all</u> premiums.

#### **DIVISION 002 – Evergreen Wreaths and Decorations**

- 1. Wreaths /creative unconventional/porch pots must have been made by the person whose name appears on the entry form and cannot have been made by contract help.
- 2. In no case shall one person, family, or farm enter more than four items—one decorated, one undecorated, one creative unconventional, and one porch pot
- 3. No wreath or decoration may be exhibited that has been sprayed with or has artificial color or other chemicals added in any manner (i.e., no antidesiccants or flame retardants).
- 4. Preregistered entries may begin to arrive on Thursday, January 4, 2024, at 10:00 A.M. and must be delivered to Maclay Lobby (Maclay Street side) of the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg by 11:00 A.M. on Friday, January 5, 2024, or they will not be eligible. New entries will not be accepted on site.
- 5. Wreaths must be made on a 12-inch ring, of natural coniferous evergreen material (no princess pine), and the outside diameter **must not exceed** 24 inches. The weight of the wreath **may not exceed 5 pounds.** Wreaths may be single- or double-faced.
- 6. Decorated wreaths must contain a bow and may contain broadleaf evergreens, or dried or other decorative material and ornaments.
- 7. Wreaths in the undecorated category must be made with one or more types of coniferous evergreens. No other materials such as sticks, berries, or leaves may be used.
- 8. Creative unconventional entries shall be made with natural evergreens (no princess pine) in any shape as long as they can be displayed properly.
- 9. Porch pot entries shall be made with natural evergreens (no princess pine) using a container of any shape no larger than 18" in any dimension. Overall size of the total arrangement may not exceed 36" high by 24".
- 10. Evergreen Wreaths and Evergreen Decorations will be scored using the following criteria:

Class 1. Undecorated Class 2. Decorated Class 3. Creative Unconventional Entry Class 4. Porch Pot Class 5. Grand Champion Class 6. Reserve Grand Champion
