-  The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture's Bureau of Dog Law Enforcement was established in 1893.
-  More stray dogs are found and picked up by dog wardens, animal control officers, and police officers in the summer months than the any other time throughout the year.
-  You can purchase your dog's license from your local County Treasurer.
-  The Pennsylvania state dog is a Great Dane.
-  Rabies is a zoonotic disease, which means it can be transferred from animals to humans.

If your dog gets lost, a license makes it more likely you'll be reunited. It's not only a smart thing to do, it's also the law.
